

WHAT IS NARCAN?

- Also known as Naloxone
- Reverses Opioid Overdose
- Safe to use on adults and children




WHEN TO USE NARCAN

- Suspected Opioid Overdose
 - Slow, shallow, or irregular breathing
 - Severe sleepiness
 - Non-Responsive
 - Small pupils
 - Gurgling sounds





- Call 911
- Perform CPR while waiting for EMSA
- If no response in 2-3 minutes, administer 2nd dose of Narcan

WHY NARCAN?

- Meth and Fentanyl are the leading substances in drug overdose
- Most overdoses occur in people unaware they used fentanyl
- Safe and Effective
 - Won't harm someone who is not overdosing
- Anyone can administer Narcan
- When in doubt, DO NOT HESITATE TO ADMINISTER NARCAN
