    - Ginny Hensley called for a motion to approve the letter of support. Beth Svetlic moved to approve. Elizebeth Hall seconded the motion. Motion carried.

### 3. Lead Agency Updates

- HUD FY23 Awards- Becky Gilgo
  - We are now 100% funded. The \$4,759,774 will cover 6 PSH projects, 4 rapid rehousing projects, 1 transitional housing project, 1 joint component traditional rapid rehousing project, 1 HMIS project, coordinated entry, and expansion for technical assistance support for the system.
- CEO Search Brian Kurtz
  - Mark Smith has been named the new CEO for Housing Solutions. He is currently the Director of Strategic Planning for the Coalition for the Homeless of Houston/Harris County (CFTH). In this role, he leads the overall strategy and daily activities of The Way Home Continuum of Care, which is managed by CFTH and is similar to A Way Home for Tulsa, Tulsa's continuum of care. Mark will officially begin April 1.

  - Lack of permanent supportive housing is still the major takeaway from the data report.

  - Across the country the 2022-2023 Pit Count was sent to Congress, and we fall about 2%-4% from the national average.

  - We wanted to put numbers to the number of people who are experiencing debt collection and how it is impacting their life experience.
